

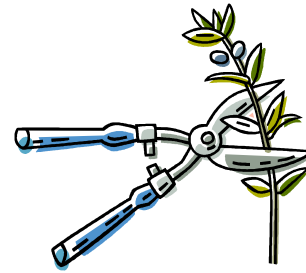
VOLUNTEER BRUSH CLEARING AND TURNTABLE EXCAVATION AT WAYLAND DEPOT

In cooperation with Friends of the Wayland Rail Trail we will be clearing brush along the entire railroad line through Wayland.



The Wayland Historical Commission is sponsoring its 13th annual volunteer Spring brush clearing at the Wayland Depot (1 Cochituate Rd.) on Saturday, May 3 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. If it rains on Saturday we will postpone until Sunday, May 4 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Volunteers are needed to help remove brush, vines and undergrowth along the inactive railroad tracks near Wayland Depot and through Wayland. We will also continue to excavate the old steam locomotive turntable pit to expose more of the circular granite walls, in addition to removing brush that has grown up along the tracks and the enginehouse site.

Volunteers should bring work gloves and pruning tools, shovels, and should wear work clothes and boots.
